



The brewery's motto is independence, progress and growth. It emphasises the traditional art of brewing adapted to the current technological developments and guarantees a reliable quality and service. Originally founded in 1874 when Jean Baptiste De Bruin started up De Peer (The Pear) brewery in Ervelde near Ghent, and has remained family run ever since. The flagship beer Gulden Draak started life as a one off beer commissioned by the major of Evergem, and is now recognised the world over. For lovers of Staminee De Garre in Bruges, the famous house beer is brewed by Van Steenberge.



Piraat. Amber coloured beer brewed with unique wine yeasts. Bittersweet and spicy aromas with warming, complex and rich hop flavours. A beer to test all senses. Its power takes you on a journey through some unique flavours based on the brewery's rich traditions.

Gulden Draak has been one of the world's best beers for years. It is a dark tripel, which in itself makes it an exceptional beer, but the complex taste with notes of caramel, roasted malt and coffee makes it unique. The name comes from the dragon on the Belfry in Gent.

Gulden Draak 9000 Quadruple. A new recipe based on 4 different malt varieties gives the Gulden Draak 9000 Quadruple a deep golden amber colour and a slightly fruity aroma. Together with the soft and slightly sweet taste, this provides a beautifully rounded bouquet with notes of dried fruit.
