Duvel Moortgat are a Flemish family owned brewery. They made their name through the Duvel brand, and have now expanded the business to incorporate other strong Belgian brands and breweries including D'Achouffe, Vedett, De Koninck, Maredsous and Liefmans.



The original Duvel Moortgat brewery. Originating in 1871 the brewery output is currently 1.4 million hectolitres a year.



Duvel is a natural beer with a subtle bitterness, a refined flavour and a distinctive hop character. The unique brewing process, which takes about 90 days, guarantees a pure character, delicate effervescence and a pleasant sweet taste of alcohol.

For Duvel Tripel Hop they use the aromatic hop called Citra. This aromatic third hop is grown in the Yakima Valley in Washington and enriches the flavour palate with fresh hints of grapefruit and tropical fruit.

This Duvel is mild, expressive and deliciously drinkable. No fewer than 6 different hop varieties are used for Duvel 6.66%: just like the classic Duvel, it's based on the noble and exclusive hop varieties Saaz and Styrian Golding. The flavour is then balanced by adding four expertly selected hop varieties to the mix, which also involves the dry-hopping method.

Vedett, the alternative Belgian brewery, there to spice up your life. Vedett is and always will be a bit of an anti-hero. For example, the logo is a penguin and we use the slogan "Penguins know why". ... That is why it fits with Vedett as antidote to the other brands which position themselves on power, masculinity and toughness.



Vedett Extra White is meant to be cloudy! And while this highly refreshing Belgian white ale may be hard to see through, she is a beer you can enjoy with all your (other) senses!
Revel in her refreshing citrus aromas with touches of coriander...
Feel the fullness of her smooth, grainy texture... And savour the subtle sweetness of her slightly perfumed, honey-like finish.

From the depths of the Ardennes in beautiful rolling countryside, Brasserie D'Achouffe commenced brewing in the late 1970s, when two brothers in law put their hobby into practice. They are synonymous with the branding of the gnomes, the family being Marcel, Malcolm, Matthew and Micheline. In 2006 the brewery was bought by Duvel Moortgat, the brothers in law moving on to found another amazing brewery Lupulus (definitely check out the Blond available here). Fortunately, the quality of D'Achouffe beers has remained and this is one gnome family well worth getting to know better.



CHOUFFE SOLEIL Made from a blend of malted barley, wheat and rye, Chouffe Soleil reveals the sweet aroma of elderflower and chamomile. Delicious citrus flavours - mandarin and lime -, enhanced with a touch of vanilla and peppery notes, titillate our taste buds. Both radiant and slightly cloudy, Chouffe Soleil can be enjoyed all year round. Pleasant times guaranteed.

LA CHOUFFE leaves citrus notes on the palate, followed by a refreshing, pleasantly spicy note, giving it a lovely lightness. With its 8% alcohol content and slightly hoppy taste, this golden beer has won over beer lovers from all over the world down the years. Its unique taste has won various awards.

Full of character, **Mc CHOUFFE** delights lovers of dark beer all over the world. Its distinctive flavour, its dark ruby colour and its fine creamy head make it a unique beer. McChouffe is also characterised by its spicy aniseed and liquorice flavours, superbly complemented by full-bodied caramel notes. Despite its robustness, McChouffe is surprisingly smooth. It even reveals delicious fruity notes, especially pear, as well as a very slight hint of bitterness at the end of the palate.

Highly sought-after by connoisseurs, **HOUBLON CHOUFFE** is a strong beer - 9% alc./vol., with a bitter and fruity taste. To recreate the bitterness of IPAs, three types of hops are added to the brews: Tomahawk, Saaz and Amarillo. Houblon Chouffe is the first Belgian IPA. Taste this magnificent beer and you can appreciate its subtle grapefruit note.



N'ICE CHOUFFE is the winter beer from the Achouffe Brewery. It is a dark beer, slightly hoppy, spiced with thyme and curaçao, and made using orange peel. It has an alcohol content of 10%. N'ice Chouffe goes well with any winter dishes.

Cherry Chouffe is a cherry-flavoured Belgian ale from Brasserie D'Achouffe. A strong Belgian ale at 8.0% ABV, Cherry Chouffe heroes the flavour of cherries. This complex ale also reveals notes of strawberry, spices and sweet Port. Pouring a scarlet colour, Cherry Chouffe offers up aromas of ripe cherries and juicy strawberry.



A Belgian wit beer, the white landscape inspired Marcel to call his new beer, which is so refreshing, smooth and spicy: Chouffe Blanche! ABV 6.5%
